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this book analyses the development of geography as a scientific discipline in brazil highlighting how the established partnerships with french geographers have helped shape scientific progress in the country it connects economic development and politics with the study of geography in brazil the author josé borzacchiello da silva includes interviews with renowned french geographers documenting their insight into the french contribution to geography in brazil the research partnerships established have been significant to the foundation and growth of the discipline in the country

in this 1994 book xavier de planhol and paul claval two of france s leading scholars in the field trace the historical geography of their country from its roots in the roman province of gaul to the 1990s they demonstrate how for centuries france was little more than an ideological concept despite its natural physical boundaries and long territorial history they examine the relatively late development of a more complex territorial geography involving political religious cultural agricultural and industrial unities and diversities the conclusion reached is that only in the twentieth century had france achieved a profound territorial unity and only now are the fragmentations of the past being overwritten

a cross between the spy who came in from the cold and a year in provence this ingenious thriller gets stunning raves from one and all a marvel olen steinhauer riveting france today elements of agatha christie and robert ludlum bookreporter com superbe jim fusilli like a good alan furst or graham greene the washingtonian engaging publishers weekly a french country murderis a story of political intrigue corruption and jealousy it is also a story of love and friendship and of course france when political intrigue drove louis morgon from a successful career at the state department he moved to a cottage in france far from washington and what he called the sordid world he took up painting he grew vegetables and flowers he ate long lovely meals on the terrace overlooking fields of sunflowers he thought that he had found happiness then one day louis s past lands squarely on his doorstep it does so in the shape of a dead man his throat has been slit he wears a cap with liberte embroidered on it except for the local cop jean renard the police are strangely uninterested this seems peculiar to renard but not to louis he knows who the murderer is he also knows that he is likely to be the next victim and there is very little he or renard or anyone else can do each clue they find raises more questions than it answers nothing is as it appears louis s best hope is to turn the tables on his murderer instead of knowledge he has only his intuition and his intelligence instead of power or influence he has only his own past louis finds himself on a lonely and dangerous journey of self discovery he thought he was beyond surprises but every turn of the road reveals new mysteries and the resolution is a shock this book was later published as le crime

themes in geographic thought first published in 1981 explores in breadth and depth the interrelationships among the history of geography geographic thought and methodology specifically focusing on the interactions between geographical research and various contemporary philosophical schools positivism pragmatism functionalism phenomenology existentialism idealism realism and marxism an attempt is made to synthesise geography's historically rich tradition with the current diversity in approaches to the discipline based on the belief that geographic thought at any point in time is a manifestation of the mutual influence between the prevailing philosophical viewpoints and the major methodological approaches in vogue each chapter presents an overview of the concrete ideas of a particular school of philosophy and stresses its relevance and impact on various aspects of geography
