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defining israel the jewish state democracy and the law is the first book in any language devoted to the controversial passage of israel's nation state law israel has no constitution and though it calls itself the jewish state there is no agreement among israelis on how that fact should be reflected in the government's laws or by its courts since the 1990s a number of civil society groups and legislators have drafted constitutions and proposed basic laws with constitutional standing that would clarify what it means for israel to be a jewish and democratic state are these bills liberal or chauvinist are they a defense of the kneset or an attack on the independence of the courts is their intention democratic or anti democratic the fight over the nation state law whether to have one and what should be in it toppled the 19th kneset's governing coalition and even after its passage on july 29 2018 remains a point of contention among israel's lawmakers and increasingly the israeli public defining israel brings together influential scholars journalists and politicians observers and participants opponents and proponents jews and arabs all debating the merits and meaning of israel's nation state law together with translations of each draft law the final law and other key documents the essays and sources in defining israel are essential to understand the ongoing debate over what it means for israel to be a jewish and democratic state

a collection of articles about israel's right of establishment as a jewish homeland and as an independent country

a revisionist account of Zionist history challenging the inevitability of a one state solution from a bold path breaking young scholar the Jewish Nation State has often been thought of as Zionism's end goal in this bracing history of the idea of the Jewish state in modern Zionism from its beginnings in the late nineteenth century until the establishment of the state of Israel Dmitry Shumsky challenges this deeply rooted assumption in doing so he complicates the narrative of the Zionist quest for full sovereignty provocatively showing how and why the leaders of the pre state Zionist movement imagined articulated and promoted theories of self determination in Palestine either as part of a multinational Ottoman state 1882-1917 or in the framework of multinational democracy in particular Shumsky focuses on the writings and policies of five key Zionist leaders from the Habsburg and Russian empires in central and eastern Europe in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries Leon Pinsker Theodor Herzl Ahad Ha'am Ze'ev Jabotinsky and David Ben-Gurion to offer a very pointed critique of Zionist historiography

can Israel be both Jewish and truly democratic how can a nation state which incorporates a large national minority with a distinct identity of its own be a state of all its citizens written by two eminent Israeli scholars a professor of constitutional law and a historian Alexander Jakobson and Amnon Rubinstein are the first to treat Zionism and Israeli experience in light of other states experiences and in particular of newly established states that have undergone constitutional changes and wrestled with issues of minorities citing various European constitutions and laws the authors explore concept of a Jewish state and its various meanings in the light of international law and the current norms of human rights as applied to other democratic societies compatible with liberal democratic norms and conclude that international reality does not accord with the concept which regards a modern liberal democracy as a culturally neutral and a nationally colourless entity in light of the new political map in Israel and the prospect of future disengagement from the West Bank Israel and the family of nations is essential reading for all those who wish to understand Israel's future challenges

a narrative chronicle of Israeli democracy that defines historic phases and follows thematic challenges to democracy including competition between religion and the rule of law the statist society and chaotic minoritocracy modern illiberal populism and the Israeli-Palestinian conflict the comprehensive portrait exposes endemic flaws of democracy in Israel but also shows that Israel has considerable capacity and responsibility to fulfill the promise of democracy

Coming Out Jewish explores the idea of Jewishness as a problem of racial/ethnic identity in the modern and post modern world it is a path breaking book that firmly places the Jewish experience on the cultural studies agenda

the nation state of israel is a short and concise overview of israel that includes its patriarchal history since abraham its geography and environment its economy culture and demographics its government and legal system zionism and the holocaust its conflicts and peace since 1948

examines the meaning of jewish politics in israel in one of the first books to ask head on what it means for israel to be a jewish state yaacov yadgar delves into what the designation jewish amounts to in the context of the sovereign nation state and what it means for the politics of the state to be identified as jewish the volume interrogates the tension between the notion of israel as a jewish state one whose very character is informed by judaism and the notion of israel as a state of the jews with the sole criterion the maintenance of a demographically jewish majority whatever the character of that majority s jewishness might or might not be the volume also examines zionism s relationship to judaism it provocatively questions whether the christian notion of supersessionism the idea that the christian church has superseded the nation of israel in god s eyes and that christians are now the true people of god may now be applied to zionism with zionism understood by some to have taken over the place of traditional judaism rendering the actual jewish religion superfluous to be a jewish state deeply informs the democratic crisis in israel discussing whether jewish laws put into effect by the state or political moves made to ensure a jewish majority can be seen as undermining democracy in our current era with nationalism resurging to be a jewish state urges a critical re assessment of the very meaning of modern jewish identity

a land with a people began as a storytelling project of jewish voice for peace new york city and subsequently transformed into a theater project performed throughout the new york city area a land with a people elevates rarely heard palestinian and jewish voices and visions it brings us the narratives of secular muslim christian and lgbtq

palestinians who endure the particular brand of settler colonialism known as zionism it relays the transformational journeys of ashkenazi mizrahi palestinian and lgbtq jews who have come to reject the received zionist narrative unflinching in their confrontation of the power dynamics that underlie their transformation process these writers find the courage to face what has happened to historic palestine and to their own families as a result stories touch hearts open minds and transform our understanding of the other as well as comprehension of our own roles and responsibilities a land with a people emerges from this reckoning contextualized by a detailed historical introduction and timeline charting 150 years of palestinian and jewish resistance to zionism this collection will stir emotions provoke fresh thinking and point to a more hopeful loving future one in which palestine israel is seen for what it is in its entirety as well as for what it can be

boas evron traces the violent fissures in israeli society to a basic incompatibility between the concept of a democratic secular state on the one hand and an integral nation defined on a religious basis on the other surveying the full sweep of jewish history evron argues that the jews were never a territorial nation judaism is instead a religious civilization for which the diaspora was not a historical coincidence but a necessary condition of its existence he concludes that israel should become a territorial state accommodating its sizeable non jewish minority in a truly democratic way

is there an israeli nation how is it related to the historical jewish people how is it related to the zionist movement under what conditions could non jews become equal members of this nation these and other questions stand at the center of the moshe berent s a nation like all nations towards the establishment of an israeli republic the mission of the zionist movement was to work toward the normalization of jewish existence to become a nation like all nations israel contrary to that aspiration is not a normal nation state since according to the formal national ethos it belongs to the jewish people and there is no recognized israeli nation dr berent asserts that the fusion of nationality and religion together with the absence of a normal nation state are the source of israel s basic problems and are responsible for israel s powerlessness to solve problems i e the status of religion in public life the relations between seculars and religious the status of non jews especially arabs the absence of a constitution the inability to agree about borders or to decide about peace and war a nation like all nations towards the establishment of an israeli republic makes the case that a separation between nationality and religion the recognition in the existence of an israeli nation and the establishment of israel as a republic as the state of the israeli nation is a pre condition for finding the solution of all of these problems
