in contrast to the sometimes overly generous treatment of german writers forced into exile by hitler s fascist regime anti nazi writers in exile applies the strict aesthetic and historical standards of literary criticism putting aside any special pleading for their anti nazi political views this critical approach leads to two important conclusions that the emigrant writers sacrifices and opposition to hitler s germany however courageous were ultimately futile and that the literature they produced was largely an aesthetic failure due in part to the very nature of the exile experience anti nazi writers in exile includes a brief description of literary life in the third reich but then concentrates on the united states as the scene of the exile s greatest activity after the outbreak of world war ii krispyn concludes that the exiles failure to achieve their political and artistic aims constitutes an important political case history within the larger history of nazi germany artistic and intellectual activities seem powerless to oppose terror and the turn of the

creative mind to political ends seemingly undermines the aesthetic force of creation

in 1933 thousands of intellectuals artists writers militants and other opponents of the nazi regime fled germany including such figures as walter benjamin ernst bloch bertolt brecht and heinrich mann they were the best of germany refusing to remain citizens in this new state that legalized terror and brutality they emigrated all across the globe to paris amsterdam prague oslo vienna new york los angeles shanghai mexico jerusalem moscow often distrusted as germans in the countries they arrived in they struggled to survive and some committed suicide in despair but throughout their exile they strove to give expression to the fight against nazism through their work in prose poetry and painting architecture film and theater weimar in exile follows these lives from the rise of national socialism to the return to their ruined homeland retracing their stories struggles setbacks and rare victories in this absorbing and magisterial work jean michel palmier provides a compelling and detailed history of those whose dignity in exile is a moving counterpoint to the story of germany under the nazis

witty charming and fiercely intelligent louis antoine comte de bougainville 1729 1811 managed in the course of a long life to play a part in nearly every facet of eighteenth century life and culture storms and dreams is a lively authoritative recounting of bougainville's adventures and achievements which ranged from seamanship and soldiering to mathematics and navigation dunmore follows bougainville from the french and indian war during which he commanded a unit in the defense of quebec city to his circumnavigation of the globe in 1766 during that trip he became one of the first westerners to visit tahiti on his return he published a book about the island that contributed greatly to tahiti's lasting reputation as a paradise of noble savages in his last years bougainville served in the senate under napoleon and was made a member of the legion of honor the first biography of bougainville in english storms and dreams opens a window to a remarkable eighteenth century life and to the greater world of the enlightenment

there he founded l b fischer corporation with fritz landshoff who had published many exiled authors in his querido verlag in amsterdam before he too was forced to leave europe wieland herzfelde introduced socialism into publishing in the u s forming the only author run press among the exiles aurora verlag art dealer and publisher otto kallir reestablished his small viennese house johannespresse in manhattan mainly to publish the work of his friend and fellow exile the poet richard beer hofmann on the west coast ernst gottlieb and felix guggenheim joined together as pazifische presse to produce deluxe editions of german fiction master of international modernism kurt wolff together with his french partner jacques schiffirin started pantheon books which went on to have an illustrious history in american publishing

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
