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traces the history of the modern olympics from 1896 to 2000 contrasting the ideal of the game with the often politicized reality

this new student textbook explores the history and meaning of the modern olympic games providing a comprehensive overview of olympism from the ancient greeks origins through to the beginnings of the international olympic committee

a rich and entertaining work of history olympics in athens 1896 brings together the following intriguing strands the rise of amateur athletics in competing countries each with its own particular stamp the enormous interest aroused by the excavation of ancient olympia the site of the ancient games the determination of the eccentric french aristocrat baron pierre de coubertin to embody the amateur athletic ideal in a revival of the games and a perception by politicians and the greek royal family that hosting coubertin s games could help to put the young greek state on the european map

coubertin's main contribution to the founding of the modern olympics was the zeal he brought to transforming an idea that had evolved over decades into the reality of olympiad i and all the olympic games held thereafter

the 1912 olympic games held in stockholm sweden were the most modern olympic games yet celebrated and the most successful of the modern era to that date much of the success is credited to the influence of viktor balck who is remembered as the father of swedish sports the 1912 olympics also featured new innovations and events a semiautomatic electrical timing device and a photo finish camera were used and the decathlon and modern pentathlon were new events this work the sixth in a series on the early olympics provides unusually extensive information on the sites dates competitors and nations of the stockholm games results for each event including cycling diving fencing rowing and sculling shooting tennis water polo and yachting among others are provided

for more than a millennium the ancient olympics captured the imaginations of the greeks until a christianized rome terminated the competitions in the fourth century ad but the olympic ideal did not die and this book is a succinct history of the ancient olympics and their modern resurgence classics professor david young who has researched the subject for over 25 years reveals how the ancient olympics evolved from modest beginnings into a grand festival attracting hundreds of highly trained athletes tens of thousands of spectators and the finest artists and poets

to paraphrase clausewitz the modern olympic games have often been politics and war by other means the olympics have been both a barometer of and an arena for international politics in spite of the fact that they were revived specifically not to be held hostage to the politics of the day this thesis examines the olympic movement from its rebirth in 1894 through today and the proposition that the realism of international politics has affected the character of the games this study also argues however that the olympic ideals have had a confluent affect in the arena of international politics and society the olympic games have always been more than mere athletic competition given that they are a focal point for billions of people around the world for a brief two week period the games are a natural forum to play out ideological and political battles the games have been used as the site of symbolic battles between nations as well as a stage in which individuals groups and nations have made political statements however they have also been a powerful global symbol of unity excellence and peace

on 6 july 2005 the international olympic committee awarded the 2012 summer olympic games to the city of london opening a new chapter in great britain's rich olympic history despite the prospect of hosting the summer games for the third time since pierre de coubertin's 1894 revival of the olympic movement the historical roots of british olympism have received limited scholarly attention with the conclusion of the 2008 beijing olympics and the passing of the baton to london rule britannia remedies that oversight this book

uncovers Britain's early Olympic involvement revealing how the British public media and leading governmental officials were strongly opposed to international Olympic competition. It explores how the British Olympic Association focused on three main factors in the midst of widespread national opposition: it embraced early Olympian spectacles as a platform for maintaining a sporting union with Ireland; it fostered a greater sense of imperial identity with Britain's white dominions; and it undertook an ambitious policy of athletic specialization designed to reverse the nation's waning fortunes in international sport. The 1908 Olympic Games were controversial. There was almost constant bickering among the American team and the British officials because of the controversies. The 1908 Olympics have been termed the Battle of Shepherd's Bush, referring to the site of the Olympic stadium. Reports of the 1908 Olympics have been rare and do not, for instance, contain full results for archery, track and field, athletics, football, soccer, gymnastics, motorboating, and shooting. A great deal of new information has been discovered by the authors, and this work gives complete results for all events. The information presented is based primarily on 1908 sources. For the first time, definitive word on the sites, dates, events, competitors, and nations, as well as the event results, are available for all of the

1908 olympic events including boxing cycling diving fencing field hockey lacrosse polo raquets swimming lawn tennis tug of war weightlifting wrestling and yachting among other sports a series of appendices include rarely seen information about the many controversies surrounding the games

the greeks started measuring time in olympiads or the interval between each olympic games in 776 bc which is when the first written records of the official games appeared in honor of the god zeus the first olympic games were held every four years from that point on a variety of artistic events including poetry song dance and theater were arranged for the pythian or delphic games which were held separately from the olympian games and thereby connected sport and culture from the outset until one man made the decision to gather the key players in paris several attempts to reestablish an international athletic event at the end of the 19th century failed due to a lack of coordination among the worldwide sporting movement consequently the olympic games were brought back to life during the inaugural olympic congress which was organized by baron pierre de coubertin and took place from june 16 23 1894 at the grand amphitheatre at the sorbonne university there were two thousand attendees twenty from belgium great britain greece ireland italy russia spain sweden and the united states representing thirteen foreign sports federations and fifty eight french delegates representing twenty four sports clubs and organizations

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
