central to debates about jesus is the issue of whether he uniquely embodies the divine while this discussion continues unabated both those who affirm and those who dismiss jesus divinity regularly eclipse the reality that in many of the earliest strands of the christian tradition when jesus divinity is proclaimed jesus is imaged as the female divine sally douglas investigates these early texts excavates the motivations for imaging jesus as woman wisdom and the complex reasons that this began to be suppressed in the 2nd and 3rd centuries the work concludes with an exploration of the powerful implications of engaging with the ancient proclamation of jesus woman wisdom in contemporary context

the volume publishes papers read at the ninth international conference on the deuterocanonical books budapest 2012 the title of the conference and the issuing volume covers an on the one hand extremely important and on the other hand regrettably neglected aspect particularly of the ancient jewish and christian traditions traditional manifestations of both judaism and christianity are predominantly masculine theological

constructions despite their harsh masculine orientation however neither judaism nor christianity lacks elaboration on the female principle when an ancient author chooses female imagery in order to make his message more emphatic the female body as such forms an integral part of their metaphors the contributions in this volume explore this phenomenon within the literature of early judaism and within its broad environments

this study is on the figure *qan* *qan* and *q* *qan* also commonly called the strange woman in proverbs 1 9 it is an attempt to understand the meaning which defines her and the origin and development of her motif the first part argues against defining her as a sexual predator but as an ethnic foreigner according to the lexical studies of *qan* and *qan* it traces her origin within the hebrew scripture the legal documents and especially to the dtrh s portrayal of foreign women wives hence it distinguishes the two motifs the motif of the adulteress and the motif of the foreign woman the latter which symbolizes the temptation to apostasy the study will then go on to explain how the writer of proverbs 1 9 employs this motif of the foreign woman in his poetic composition the second part tracks the development of this motif through the subsequent jewish wisdom literature and observes how it changes and loses the foreignness of her original motif in eccl 7 26 4q184 lxx proverbs hebrew ben sira greek ben sira and finally disappears in wisdom of solomon it proffers to understand this gradual transformation against a background of social and religious change

this collection of essays by carol a newsom explores the indispensable role that rhetoric and hermeneutics play in the production and reception of biblical and second temple literature some of the essays are methodological and programmatic while others provide extended case studies because rhetoric is as kenneth burke put it a strategy for encompassing a situation the analysis of rhetoric illumines the ways in which texts engage particular historical moments shape and reshape communities and even construct new models of self and agency the essays in this book not only explore how ancient texts hermeneutically engage existing traditions but also how they themselves have become the objects of hermeneutical transformation in contexts ranging from ancient

sectarian judaism to the politics of post world war i and ii germany and america to modern film criticism and feminist re reading

respected old testament scholar craig bartholomew coauthor of the well received drama of scripture provides a careful exegetical reading of ecclesiastes in this addition to the baker commentary on the old testament wisdom and psalms series along with helpful translation and commentary ecclesiastes considers the theological implications of the text and its literary historical and grammatical dimensions footnotes deal with many of the technical matters allowing readers of varying levels of interest and training to read and profit from the commentary and to engage the biblical text at an appropriate level pastors teachers and all serious students of the bible will find here an accessible commentary that will serve as an excellent resource for their study
